Crestron Sonnex<sup>®</sup> speakers deliver a powerful 'fragrance' of music that flows throughout each area.

To ensure the best possible user experience, the DC Home Systems team designed a custom user interface consistent with the owner's other properties. Additionally, each feature in the playhouse can be controlled from anywhere in the world via the Crestron Mobile App. To ensure privacy, surveillance cameras can be deactivated when the client activates home-mode on the Crestron control keypad, which also activates the HVAC system, sets the lighting, and in the winter months, turns on the fireplace.





With limited space in the AV rack room, and with an immense amount of technology required for the project, Nick and his team managed to configure all the equipment to fit into three head-end racks, thus ensuring that the technology would not intrude or distract from the overall space.
