A combination of permanently installed DM NVX encoders/decoders and others that can be placed wherever needed provides the flexibility and advanced functionality to support Sixth & I's unique array of events.

"As Sixth & I continues to grow, the DM NVX platform provides the ability to expand their video capabilities to other areas of the building," said Biz Shaughnessy, Division Manager, MidPoint Technology Group.

Crestron's DM NVX Director[™] virtual switching appliance was implemented to manage the large networks of DM NVX endpoints, route AV signals, and simplify integration with the Crestron control system. This is especially beneficial for the management of content.

In addition, a Crestron TSW touch screen, featuring an intuitive user interface, was installed to enable simple fingertip control of the entire AV system throughout the synagogue. Scenes were programmed to support the different types of events so that all settings for each one can be implemented with just a single tap.
