The DM-MD32X32 is Crestron DigitalMedia™ Switcher, providing the foundation for a complete DigitalMedia system, delivering a true high-definition multi-room AV signal routing solution. It uses the following memory types: EEPROM, SRAM, SDRAM and FLASH PROM. The memory used in this unit holds only firmware, operational parameters and user presets. No user audio/video data is retained in memory upon power down.
